Special offers such as the Westin Club, an exclusive lounge on the top floor, round out any stay, offering wonderful opportunities to regenerate, even for those with a full schedule.

**General Manager & team**

Dutch-born Paul Peters has been in charge of the Westin Grand München since 2013. At 47, the passionate hotelier can look back on over 25 years in the business, including stints as General Manager of the Sheraton Stockholm Hotel and the Westin Rotterdam. As Complex General Manager, he also leads the the Sheraton München Arabellapark Hotel located opposite. At the two hotels, a team of over 420 people attend to the needs of their guests.

**Location & connections**

The Westin Grand München is situated in the Bogenhausen district at Effnerplatz and in the Arabellapark. The hotel is highly accessible by car or on public transport, with subway and tram stations and the ring road *Mittlere Ring* in the direct vicinity. It is in easy reach of the nearby downtown area, with its many sights, as well as the trade fair center and airport.

**Wellness, fitness and regeneration**

Hotel guests and locals alike can find ample space for regeneration in the capacious ArabellaSpa, one of the largest hotel day spas in Munich. The crystal-clear water of the 12 by 5-m pool with integrated whirlpool, the Finish sauna (90°C), the Roman steam bath (40°C) and the infrared thermium (60°C) and a cutting-edge solarium are the ideal places to unwind. In the five treatment rooms, trained masseurs and beauticians will soothe body and soul with revitalizing and relaxing treatments. Products from Babor are used at the ArabellaSpa. The WestinWORKOUT® gym is equipped with state-of-the art cardio and weight training equipment. Open around the clock, it offers everything guests need to keep up a beneficial, effective training program on the road. Professional fitness coaching is also available to ensure ideal training conditions. Qualified trainers can create customized fitness programs for individuals or groups on request.

### **Rooms & suites**

All 627 rooms and suites offer a soothing haven from the bustle of the city. Elegantly designed in warm shades, they feature a Heavenly Bed, specially designed for Westin Hotels & Resorts, to ensure a deeply refreshing night's sleep. The dual-headed rain showers with an extra-large spraying radius turn showering into a particularly invigorating experience. The 60 rooms on the 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> floors of the 23-story building were completely renovated in the summer of 2016 according to a new design concept dubbed "Isarrauschen" (the murmur of the Isar). These "Bavarian floors" pay homage to the hotel's location in city of Munich.

### **Westin Club rooms**

The exclusive rooms in the "Westin Club" category are located on the top floors, from the 19<sup>th</sup> floor upwards, and not only command a superb view over Munich and the city's landmarks, but also offer some very special perks, such as access to the Westin Club and free high-speed Internet.

### **The Westin Club**

The Westin Club on the 24<sup>th</sup> floor is reserved for guests of the hotel's 130 Club rooms and 30 suites and offers a breathtaking view over Munich, stretching all the way out to the foothills of the Bavarian Alps. In a tranquil lounge atmosphere, guests can tuck into a continental breakfast (available in addition to the breakfast buffet in the Restaurant ZEN) and can help themselves to drinks and snacks all day. Fast W-LAN, a selection of international daily newspapers and large flat-screen TVs with news bulletins are among the many extras guests can expect at the Westin Club. Providing an ideal environment for focused working, conferring with business associates or a private gathering, the Westin Club is a wonderful retreat and perfect for small meetings.

### **Westin Sky Suite**

Anyone entering the 160-m<sup>2</sup> suite on the 22<sup>nd</sup> floor will be captivated by the magnificent view and the cunning and ambitious design. Featuring exclusive furnishings and accessories, elegant sofas and several flat-screen TVs, the spacious living area truly hits the mark. And the elegantly composed fittings don't stop at the doors to the two bedrooms. The extra-large 2.4 by 2.2-m Heavenly Bed in the master bedroom beckons with the prospect of blissful slumbers. The elaborately designed en-suite bathroom offers ample space for relaxation. With a free-standing separate bathtub, shower, a combined aroma-therapy steam bath and such luxurious details as an in-mirror TV, the Westin Sky Suite leaves nothing to be desired. The spacious, very high-ceilinged 1,000-m<sup>2</sup> ballroom is an ideal venue for all manner of events, from weddings to automotive presentations. Together with the adjacent Sheraton München Arabellapark Hotel, the Westin Grand Munich is the largest hotel conference complex in southern Germany, with 33 event rooms and 1,073 rooms.

### **History & ownership**

The current Westin Grand München was opened in 1972, the year that the Summer Olympics were held in Munich, under the name Sheraton Hotel München (ITT Sheraton). It began operating under the name ArabellaSheraton Grand Hotel in April 2000. In the winter of 2007, the hotel was rebranded as the Westin Grand München; since then, it has developed into a "flagship Westin" in Europe and frequently has been used as a pilot hotel when the brand introduced new services and programs, most recently when the lobby was redesigned as Germany's first *Westin Haven*, a reinterpretation of the classical hotel foyer as a welcoming zone in which guests can arrive, unwind and recharge. The striking high-rise building which houses the Westin Grand München, is the property of Bayrischer Hausbau and is operated by Arabella Hospitality, a subsidiary of the Schörghuber Group.

### **Unique features**

Together with the adjacent Sheraton München Arabellapark Hotel, the Westin Grand Munich is the largest hotel conference complex in southern Germany, with 33 event rooms and 1,073 guest rooms. From its top floors, the Westin Grand München commands a spectacular view over the Bavarian capital, particularly from the Westin Club and the loftiest presidential suite in the city, the 160-m<sup>2</sup> Sky Suite. The spacious ArabellaSpa is one of the largest day spas in Munich.
